## **Judging Considerations**

Consideration for the nomination will include demonstrated evidence of the following:

- The PR professional demonstrates the value of a year-round, ongoing program of internal and external communications.
- The PR professional practices communication management techniques, such as empowering staff, working with the community, interacting with the media, and building partnerships with other entities.
- The PR professional demonstrates excellent personal communication skills such as ethics, honesty, openness, and good listening skills.
- The PR professional demonstrates outstanding leadership in school communications/public relations through involvement in either local, state or national activities that support, promote, and grow the profession (e.g. contributes to the body of work or knowledge by sharing information/documents, encourages other professionals through networking, and serves on communication or PR-related task forces, committees, or boards).

- Official entry form
- Statement of nomination: Two single-sided typed pages indicating why the nominee should be considered, based on the criteria listed for this nomination category.
- Biographical sketch of the nominee (limited to one single-sided page)
- One Letter of recommendation (limited to one single-sided page)
- Additional documentation, such as newspaper columns, employee communications, etc. (limited to six single-sided pages)
- The original entry form with four copies

• Entries will be reviewed over the summer. Winners will be announced in the fall of 2018 and recognized at the MSPRA annual meeting in March.

## **Procedures / Criteria**

- 1. The Gerri Allen Outstanding School Communicator award will be promoted using all available resources.
- 2. The nominee must be a current employee of a public school district or educational agency whose focus is on strategic communications and public relations. Only MSPRA members in good standing may be recognized.
- 3. All individuals are welcome to nominate an outstanding candidate. To check the MSPRA membership of your nominee, please email <u>mspraboard@gmail.com</u>.
- 4. All entries must include the official entry form, statement of nomination, biographical sketch, one letter of recommendation and up to six one-sided pages of additional documentation.
- 5. Judges will review a maximum of eleven single-sided pages per entry which includes the entry form. Entries that exceed the total page count will not be reviewed in their entirety.
- 6. Five sets of nomination paperwork must be received at MSPRA offices by May 18. Entries that do not follow these procedures will be disqualified.
- 7. A selection committee appointed by the MSPRA president will be comprised of two MSPRA executive board members, one MSPRA member, and one current or former school PR professional.
- 8. The award will be presented at the Annual MSPRA Conference. MSPRA will provide complimentary conference registration.
